## Ticket Details

### AmCare (NACRS)

#### PR-1265 Intervention 5PC80JK

When O086\* was entered as main or other problem in combination with main/other intervention the following incorrect hard error generated:

If Main Intervention is 5PC80JJ or 5PC80JK, then Main or Other problem O71301, O71304 or O086- must also be coded

If Other Intervention is 5PC80JJ or 5PC80JK, then Main or Other problem O71301, O71304 or O086- must also be coded

This has been resolved.

### CACS

#### PR-1266 CACS Box Missing

A permissions issue caused the CACS Box to be removed for some NACRS Level 3 clients (Ontario excluded). This CACS box will be restored.

### Edits Management Tool (EMT)

#### PR-1260 Edits Management Tool (EMT): Weight in kg Error

When creating a Field Condition using the Weight (kg), if the field condition was in the correct range an incorrect hard edit was generating. This has been resolved.

### Full System

#### ED-1263 M\_Login Table: Invalid Password

Invalid passwords at login were previously stored in plain text, they will now be encrypted for improved security measures.

#### ED-1268 Invalid Password Login - Workstation

M\_Login Table: On 295.1.1 any failed login attempts will now show the workstation.
